- SharePoint requires extensive scoping and development work to achieve a working model, lasting 6 months to 1.2 years.
- Out of the box customizations are extremely limited. Branding requires additional knowledge and resources to accomplish.
- SharePoint uses a model in which lines of business remain siloed. It does not have a governance model that allows for your company to operate together as a team, and relies heavily on IT.
- SharePoint is built on sites with no unifying structure. Tying together all standalone sites will be an ongoing requirement.
- Content cannot be made or distributed in a personalized manner, making it extremely difficult to maintain an engaged and aligned workforce without a significant increase in full-time resources.
- SharePoint is fantastic at connecting

 Microsoft products, but often requires heavy development work to connect some third-party applications.


